

# Meridian 561 RS232 Interface

The RS232 interface for the 561 can be operated from any terminal, such as a Windows 95 PC running Hyperterminal, which operates at 9600 baud with 1 start bit, 1 stop bit and no parity. Commands take the form of 2 ASCII characters, in some cases followed by a signed argument ('nn' below). All characters are echoed by the controller. A carriage return character will execute the command, and backspace is also implemented. When a command is executed, the 561 will return 12 characters (or 4 for the commands marked \*). Please note that zero characters are returned as upper case O.

The following table lists the commands available and shows examples of the messages returned. These always correspond to the display on the front panel.
